

# **citizenM ‘proof of vaccination’ policy Seattle**

## **What you need to know:**

From **25 October**, all hotel guests and visitors over 12 years old must show one of the following documents with a government-issued ID (identity card, passport or driver’s licence):

- proof of full vaccination with a COVID-19 vaccine authorized by the FDA or WHO, or
- negative FDA-approved PCR test taken within the last 72 hours, or
- negative FDA-approved rapid test administered by a testing agent

Please show one of the following vaccination passes at the kiosks:

- CDC vaccination card (or photo)
- your immunization records from the WA Department of Health website
- a digital or printed certificate from MyIRMobile
- an official immunisation record of a COVID-19 vaccine administered outside the USA
- all international travellers must show a vaccination card, photo or EU app with QR code

Medical and religious vaccine exemptions are not accepted in place of a vaccine verification or negative test. We do not accept self-administered antigen tests.
